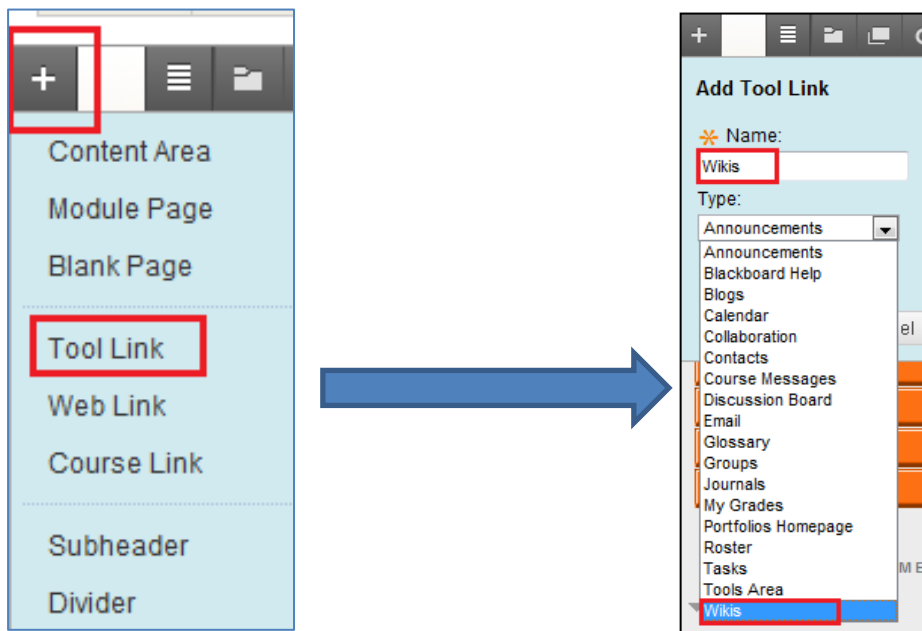

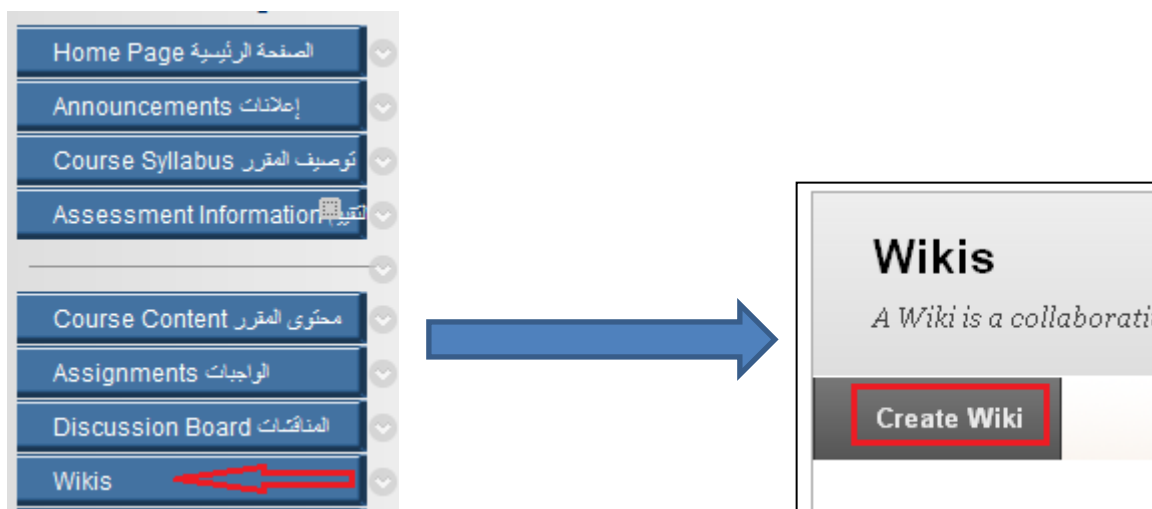
Wikis in Blackboard 9.1: *Instructions for faculty members*

To Create a Wiki in your course:

- 1- Login to your course on Blackborad 9.1
- 2- Add the Wiki tool link to the main menu by clicking on the **+** and then selecting **“Tool Link”** and **“Wikis”**



- 3- Click on the **Wiki** link on the left menu and then click on **“Create Wiki”**

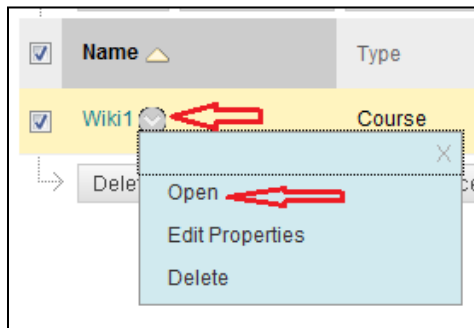

1- Abstract
